Background of Efforts

Accenture is a leading global professional services company that helps the world's leading businesses, governments and other organizations build their digital core, optimize their operations, accelerate revenue growth and enhance citizen services—creating tangible value at speed and scale. As use of digital technology and IT has become a business imperative, ensuring strong resilience is required. Accenture Security has more than 16,000 cybersecurity professionals globally and provides security services to over 3,100 clients (as of 2022). While a global shortage of cybersecurity workforce remains critical, and it is said there is a shortage of more than 50,000 security professionals in Japan. According to CompTIA's international trends in technology and workforce report, satisfaction levels of security among firms in Japan are lower when compared to overall results (34% vs. 69%) and top reported challenges to improving cybersecurity include lack of budget dedicated to cybersecurity followed by low understanding of cybersecurity trends or new threats. Accenture Security tackles the cybersecurity talent shortage in Japan through collaboration with CompTIA.



Expansion of internship

To take these initiatives a step further, Accenture will be offering an internship focused on cybersecurity. The internship curriculum will be designed to increase students' cybersecurity proficiency and motivate them to pursue a career in the field. It includes:

- Lectures on incident response, forensics, and attack simulation using a virtual environment by the Security Operation Center (SOC) and Incident Response (IR) team
